<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: This is work involving responsibility for performing rough or semi-skilled mechanical tasks of a recurring nature. Employees in this class assist skilled workmen in a variety of construction, installation, maintenance and repair work. General instructions are received regarding routine jobs with detailed instructions on new or unusual assignments.
