<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: This position is responsible for conducting specialized developmentally appropriate interviews of children that have allegations of sexual abuse, severe physical abuse, and/or neglect. The incumbent may provide testimony in court regarding cases when necessary. Work is performed under the direct supervision of the Child Advocacy Center Coordinator and administrative supervision of the District Attorney. Does related work as required.
