<u>GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES</u>: Operates one or more types of specialized heavy highway maintenance and construction equipment and performs a variety of manual tasks in connection with such operations. Includes but is not limited to "fleet tandem" drivers and roller operators; does related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Work involves responsibility for the efficient operation of specialized heavy highway maintenance and construction equipment. There is greater responsibility for the safety of others. Additional responsibilities include making minor repairs to equipment and for routine servicing.
